Nevada GOED Partnering with Las Vegas HEALS to Host Panel Discussions on Diversifying Our State's Health Economy

LAS VEGAS – The Nevada Governor's Office of Economic Development (GOED) is co-hosting a symposium with Las Vegas HEALS about diversifying the health economy in Nevada on Thursday that will feature medical and health professionals discussing the future of health research and development in the state.

"As the health care market continues to evolve we must share our insights, ideas and solutions on how we can further diversify the health economy beyond clinical services."

The event will feature panels with Nevada companies discussing how their health research and development products can help grow and diversify the state's health economy; strategies to grow a new workforce and entrepreneurship in health research and development; and how unique opportunities in the field will help diversify our state's economy.

"Symposiums like this allows us to build new opportunities through partnerships among health care providers, universities, heath care administrators and government officials," said Doug Geinzer, Las Vegas HEALS Chief Executive Officer. "We remain hopeful that these partnerships will grow a stronger health economy in Nevada."
