**Unemployment Rate Update**  
**November 17, 2016**

**Determination of Unemployment Status in Each County**

Board Resolution 2015-1230 states that “for the purpose of determining the rate of unemployment in a county said rate of unemployment shall be the county-level, 12-month unemployment rate as established by the Research and Analysis Division of the Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (“DETR”). Below are the updated numbers through September 30, 2016. The staff recommends no change to the Board determination at the May 19, 2016 meeting.
